Accommodation, access to certain services, such as amusement parks, restaurants, concert venues, etc.

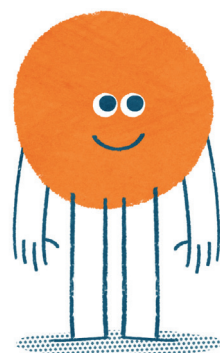
- **PUBLIC SERVICES**

Municipal services, hospitals, schools, etc.

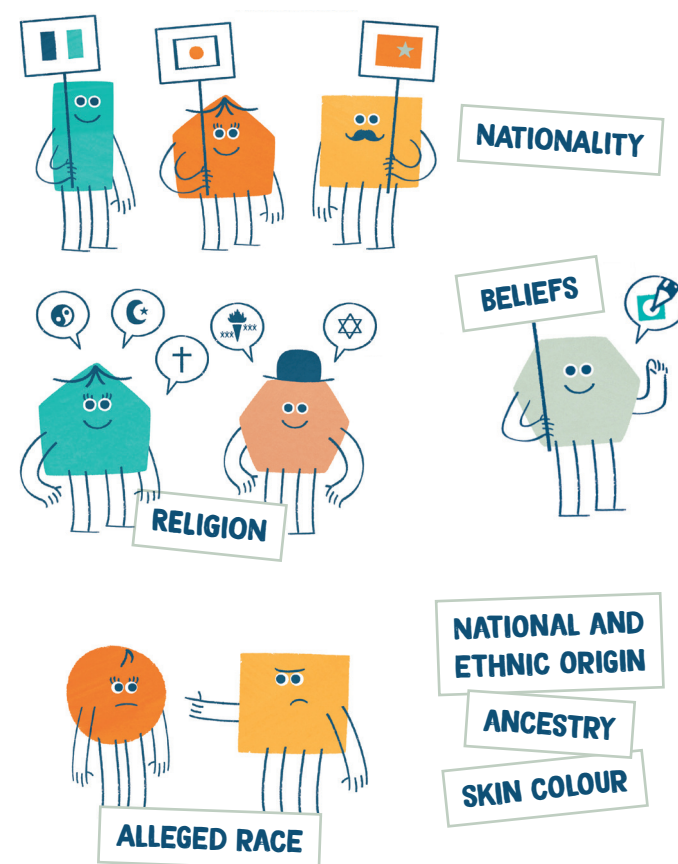

Newspapers, television, social networks

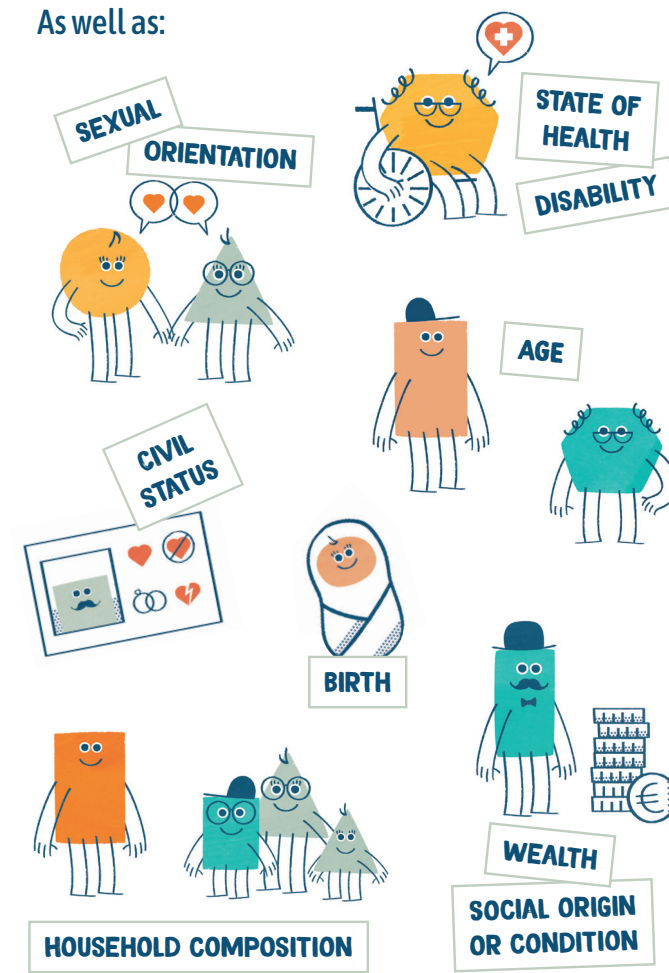
